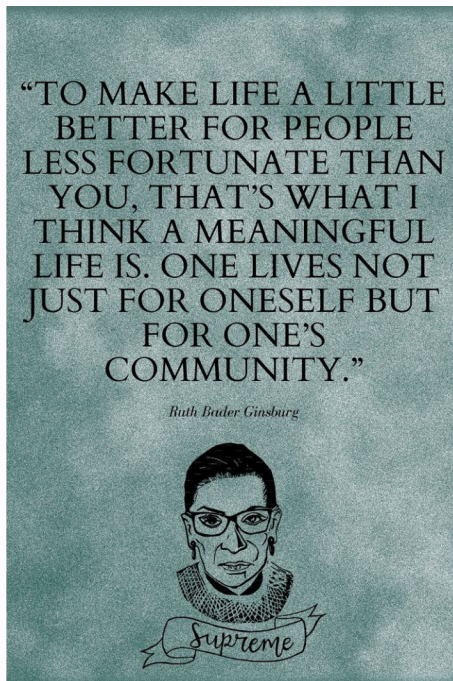


# Woman's Club of Asbury Park
